Trenton resident, George Vanderpool, 74, passed away at his home at 103 West 17th Street Tuesday evening August 24, 2010 while under hospice care.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 PM Friday at the First Assembly of God in Trenton. A scheduled family visitation will be held from 7:00 until 8:00 PM Thursday at the Resthaven Mortuary at Trenton. He was employed at American Sterilizer Company and worked on medical equipment in the Kansas City area for 10 years.

He was a member of the First Assembly of God and the Major Dale Stepp Post # 31 American Legion.

Mr. Vanderpool is survived by his wife, Willa of the home; 3 sons; David Vanderpool of Kennett, MO, Richard Vanderpool of Hopkinton, MA and Jeffrey Vanderpool of Gardner, KS; a sister, Mary Tharp of Harrington, KS; 2 brothers, James and William Vanderpool both of Des Moines, IA and by 10 grandchildren.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by one brother Robert Vanderpool.
