Earl Dean Holt, an 80 year old rural Trenton resident, passed away at 8:15 p.m. on Saturday, October 23, 2010 at his home where he was under hospice care.

The body was cremated. A Celebration of Life service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 27, 2010 at the Hodge Presbyterian Church of Trenton. Rev. Barry Robinson will officiate. A reception will follow the service in the church's Fellowship Room.

Mr. Holt was born on August 12, 1930 in Princeton, MO the son of Schuyler and Rosa Browning Holt. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War.
