Freddie Lee Altiser, an 82 year old Newtown, MO resident, passed away at 12:10 a.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2012 at his

home in Newtown.

He then attended Kirksville College and Weltech College. Fred taught school before working as a welder and working on all of the phases of the Space Program. He also worked for Monsanto in the Astroturf division and later installing security systems in Carefree, AZ. More recently he worked as an OATS bus driver. He served during the Korean War in the United States Air Force from 1951 through 1953. On March 3, 1955 he was united in marriage to Faye Nowlin in Carrollton, MO. Fred loved traveling, visiting with family, and gardening. He was well known for sharing his produce with all. In recent years, he took up working with stained glass and made many pieces for family and friends. He was a member of the Masons, Shriners, Eastern Star, American Legion and was a Dad for Jobs Daughters and Demolays.
