Matthew J. Mattson, Jr., "Bud" age 92, a resident of Pasadena for 27 years, and previously of Rosedale, died on June 12, 2012 at Baltimore Washington Medical Center of congestive heart failure after a 7 week illness.

He was born on February 13, 1920, in Baltimore, to the late Bertha A. (nee Hayes) and Matthew J. Mattson.
