Died: Monday, October 31, 2011

Charles Vincent Alfinito, Sr., "Cheelay", 73, a resident of Pasadena for 45 years, and formerly of Baltimore, died at home on October 31, 2011 after a 17 month illness.

He was born January 9, 1938, in Baltimore, and joined the US Army after high school, serving from 1955 to 1959.
