Upon graduating from high school in 1964, Weldon enlisted in the US Air Force. (Vietnam Area), and was stationed in Thailand and Okinawa, Japan. In November 1968 after his military discharge he met Rita Siltala and they were married on June 14, 1969 at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Fennimore.

Weldon developed an early interest in computers and furthered his education in that field, specializing in jobs in the food and dairy industry working on computer programing. His jobs took him all over the US, Canada, Mexico, Honduras, Columbia, Panama, Peru, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic.
