

In Loving Memory

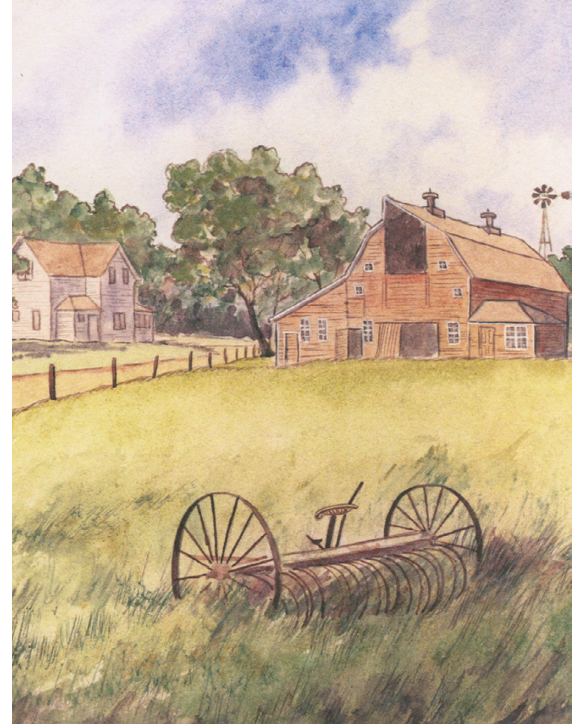
The greatest of these is love, we know;
