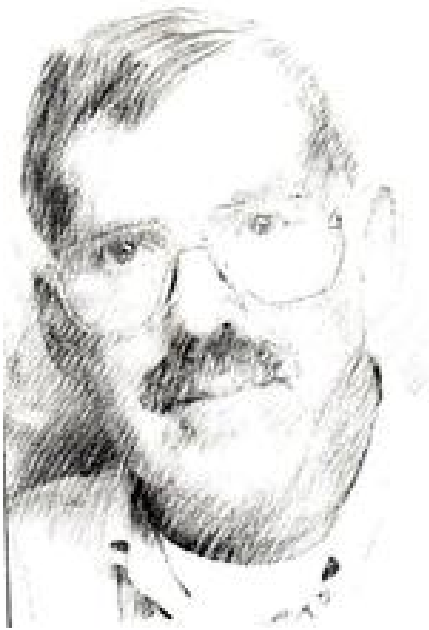




Obituary
