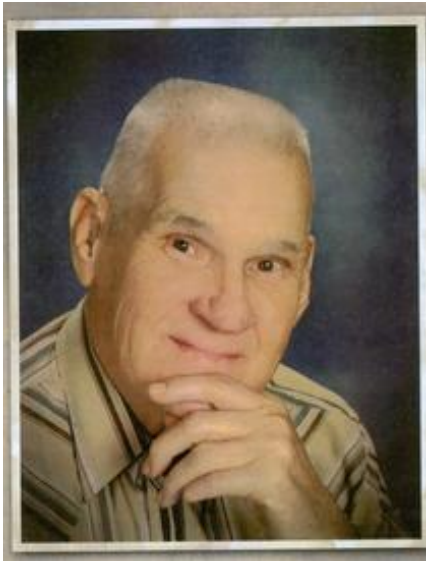




Obituary
