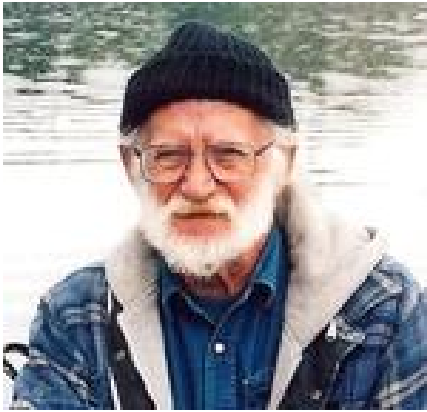




Obituary
