One of her passions was the application of nursing & medical practices in different cultures, so she followed up with a PhD in Cultural Anthropology. While studying for her Doctorate she traveled to Peru to help establish a clinic in Arequipa, her dissertation explored health practices amoung Italian women in Boston's North End. She shared her interests through teaching, she taught at Boston Collge for 12 years, & later moved to Ohio where she finished her career at Case Western Reserve University. She was an independent woman who lived a full & interesting life.
