Cocuzzo, Daniel A. Age 97, a longtime resident of Everett, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, November 25th surrounded by his loving family. Daniel was born on June 12, 1919 in Brighton, MA to immigrant parents, Giuseppe and Giovanna Cocuzzo. He attended Brighton High School. In 1940, Daniel enlisted in the United States Army. During World War II, he served as a 1st Lieutenant in the 8th Air Force as a Bombardier and Navigator on B-24's in the European Theatre. He was stationed in England and completed 31 missions including the D-Day Invasion. As a result of his service, he was awarded the Silver Star with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters, and a Purple Heart. Upon returning home, he attended Northeastern University graduating Summa Cum Laude with Bachelors of Science degree in Civil Engineering. After graduation, he began his 35 year career as a Civil Engineer for the City of Boston, eventually, assuming the position of the Principal Engineer for the Parks and Recreation Department.

Daniel loved watching his grandchildren participating in various sports. He was an avid Red Sox and Patriots fan. He was a longtime parishioner of Immaculate Conception Parish in Everett, and a member of the Carondelet Fathers Club of the Sisters of Saint Joseph of Boston.

Beloved husband of late Alice M. (Desmond)Cocuzzo , Devoted Father of Ellen(Cocuzzo) Ciarlone and her husband Donald of Billerica, Jean Cocuzzo and her husband, Harvey Petersiel of Hamilton, Ann Cocuzzo of Everett, and Michael Cocuzzo and his partner, Cathy Cotter of North Andover.
