Mr. Caroselli served in the United States Marine Corps during World War II and took part in the Central Pacific Campaign; he attained the rank of First Lieutenant. Mr. Caroselli worked until he was ninety-two and most of his career was in sales. He worked for many years as a manufacturer's representative for the St. Charles Mfg. Co. He ended his career as a security guard for the Harvard Medical School. He was a long time resident of Wakefield, MA where he was active in many civic organizations including the Kiwanis Club and the United Way. He was an avid golfer and volunteer giving his time to many community organizations including the Lake Forest Library Book Sale and the First Presbyterian Church Rummage Sale.
