Arnold "Arn" E. Boardman, 85, of Laconia, NH, formally of Everett, died at the Lakes Region General Hospital on Friday,

He also produced a book on Everett's Football Teams since they started playing in 1892 through 2007. Arn is a member of the Everett "E" Club and is listed as their Historian on Everett Football.
